



Community Update

Dear Neighbour,

We are pleased to advise you that the Waste Water Treatment Plant at Livingstone Beef is now fully constructed and we are beginning commissioning, ahead of full scale operation in two months' time.



The waste water treatment ponds are a three-stage biological process

The Waste Water Treatment Plant is an \$8.7 million investment by AACo which will improve the waste water quality and associated odour produced by the Abattoir.

The commissioning phase is a carefully staged process to develop the biological communities within the two lagoons of the Plant.

We will do this by slowly introducing wastewater to the covered anaerobic lagoon, allowing the microbiology within the lagoon to activate.

There will be occasional risk of odour during commissioning when the Plant will need to revert to the pre-existing wastewater treatment methods.

We have put in place as many precautions as we can to minimise odour during this transition phase from the old to the new system.

Once we are through these first few weeks all wastewater will be processed through the new Plant which will dramatically reduce the risk of odour from the operations in all weather conditions.
