Key Responsibilities

General

- Coordinate the daily activities and resources required across various departments at the feedlot
- Monitor and report to the Relevant Senior Manager



- Assist the Feedlot Manager in the facilitation and coordination of management meetings that are conducted weekly and any other operational meetings required across the feedlot
- Ensure that all Quality Assurance, OH&S and Environmental policies and procedures are being implemented throughout the feedlot
- Take a leadership role in the implementation of the training systems across the feedlot to ensure that adequate training and the development of staff skills meets the business requirements
- Manage cost responsibilities within budgetary limitations of the business in consultation with the Feedlot Manager
- Provide positive input into the planning and structuring of the business operational requirements in conjunction with executive management and feedlot management where required.

Livestock

- Ensure the coordination of arrivals, induction, dispatch and other daily livestock activities are organised daily in conjunction with the Livestock Manager
- Assist in cattle health management processes and monitor and report as required
- Responsible for ensuring that adequate supplies of animal husbandry products are on site at all times
- Assist with all relevant recording and reports that are required and monitor the information in them when required
- Engage with feedlot animal health consultants when required

Mill

- Ensure that all milling and feeding activities are being conducted in conjunction with mill management
- Ensure that feed commodities are processed and delivered within the business specifications
- Monitor the daily feed allocation for the purpose of general animal consumption and health across the feedlot
- Assist the mill manager and maintenance department with coordination of priorities when a breakdown occurs, or preventative maintenance is required that interrupts the daily feeding or milling operations
- Engage with feedlot animal nutritional consultants when required

Maintenance

- Oversee the day to day operations of the maintenance crew including managing costs and time frames of completion of tasks.
- Help prioritise and facilitate maintenance tasks across the feedlot.
