Our site

Canobie Station is located 200km north of Cloncurry and 280km south of Normanton. The property is a breeding station running predominantly Brahman x cattle. The Cloncurry River runs through the property which provides permanent water. Canobie has a good mixture of black soils and lighter red country, and the properties Alcalá and Wondoola are operated as part of the Canobie aggregation.

About the role

This position will work closely with the onsite Mechanic based our station workshop, you will be mechanically minded and show a keen interest in developing your skills in repair of station vehicles and machinery. In this important role your duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Repair and maintain all station machinery
- Ensure work place health and safety procedures are maintained
- Maintain an efficient workshop by keeping floors, benches and equipment clean and serviceable
- Undertake regular services and over-hauls, and complete repairs and maintenance using, where necessary, power tools, welders and air tools
- Fabricate, weld and assemble structural metal products
- Assisting in Bore Repairs (Mono & Submersible) Training Provided
- Operate machinery when required
- Assist with general maintenance of buildings and station structures, including performing routine daily checks and services of equipment
- Detailed Servicing and record Keeping of all Plant and Machinery
- Perform your job in a safe manner in line with AACo safety programs and procedures
- Assisting elsewhere on the property if required
