### Our site

Montejinni Station is located in the Victoria River District, 15km south west of Top Springs, 320km south west of Katherine and 640km south of Darwin.

# **Duties & Responsibilities**

As our Bore Runner your top priority will be keeping the supply of water up to our cattle, checking and cleaning troughs and servicing motors. In this important role your duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Responsible for water maintenance across designated areas of the station
- Observation and maintenance of watering points
- Travelling between water points in a 4WD vehicle
- Maintenance of 4WD vehicle, small diesel pumps and spare parts
- Maintenance of Mono pump systems, solar pumps
- At each water source (bore) check and maintain the following: turkey nest or tank level, turkey nest or tank fences, troughs and motors.
- Reporting any issues back to the Station Manager
- Keep records in writing of: bores checked, level of water at each turkey next, number of cattle at each trough, maintenance on fences, troughs and motors
- Assisting elsewhere on the property if required
- Perform your job in a safe manner in line with AACo safety programs and procedures

### Requirements

- Current manual drivers licence
- Previous experience in a similar role preferred but not essential
- Ability to co-ordinate a daily and weekly work schedule
- Ability to work both alone and as part of a team



# Working Environment

This job requires the ability to comprehend written and oral operational and safety instructions and related rules, policies and memos, and to communicate clearly with your co-workers and supervisors.
